Notice of Race

Event: *Nordic and Swedish F18 Championship*

Date: *September 13-15, 2019*

Organizer: *Djursholms Segelklubb (DSK)*

1. Rules

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and with appendix S.

The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located at regatta office.

1.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies. [DP]

1.3 Competitors shall when afloat wear personal flotation devices. This rule does not apply to short-term replacement or adjustment of clothing or personal equipment. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices. This changes RRS 40. A boat that breaks this rule may be warned or penalized at the discretion of the protest committee (DP).

2. Eligibility requirements

2.1 To be entitled to participate in Nordic Sailing Federation championships each competitor must comply with [World Sailing Regulation 19](#).

2.2 All competitors shall be members of a club or organization affiliated to a World Sailing member national authority.

2.3 All participants must be up to date members of their national F18 Class Association.

2.4 The competitor that is in charge on board shall follow Swedish Sailing Federations racing license regulation for competitors. This regulation applies from the year the competitor reach the age of 13. Competitors from other countries than Sweden are exempt from this regulation.

- 2.5 In order to be awarded the title Nordic Champion (NC) the competitors shall be Nordic citizens or have resided in a Nordic country for at least six months the last twelve months before the regatta starts.
- 2.6 In order to be awarded the title Swedish Champion (SC) the competitors shall be Swedish citizens or have resided in Sweden for at least six months the last twelve months before the regatta starts.
- 2.7 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance.
- 2.8 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

3. Entries

- 3.1 Entry shall be made not later than 2019-08-30 by the registrations form at [Djursholms segelklubbs web site](#).
The entry shall include the following: sail number, boat club, skipper, crew, address, mobile phone number.

The entry fee is SEK 2500.

- 3.2 Late entries will be accepted until the end of registration on September 13th, 2019 and then to the fee 3500 SEK
- 3.3 The entry fee shall be paid in conjunction with the registration
From the registration fee, 100 SEK is allocated to Swedish Sailing Federation's racing fee.

The entry fee also includes food at the regatta dinner.

4. Registration and measurement checks

- 4.1 Registrations shall be made at the Race office at Nynäshamn YC club house
- 4.2 Measurement certificates and membership in a National Class Association shall be presented prior to racing.
- 4.3 Swedish competitors that is in charge onboard, according to §1.4, shall be able to present a valid license for competitor.
- 4.4 A boat or equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with the class rules and sailing instructions. On the water, the race- or/and the technical committee can instruct a boat to proceed immediately to a prescribed location for inspection.

- 4.5 Substitution of damaged or lost equipment will not be allowed unless approved by the race committee. Requests for substitution shall be made to the Race committee at the first reasonable opportunity.
- 4.6 A competitor may not be substituted without the written permission of the Race committee.

5. Time schedule

6. Racing area

6.1 The fleet races take place outside Nynäshamn, see appendix A

7. The course

7.1 The courses of the fleet races will be defined in the sailing instructions. A trapezoid course or windward/leeward course may be used.

8. Scoring

8.1 The low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply, modified so that when fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores. When from four to nine races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. When ten or more races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

8.2 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.

9. Penalty system

9.1 Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

10. Prizes

10.1 Championship plaquettes and titles for the Nordic Championship may be awarded if six or more boats from at least three different Nordic countries have crossed the finish line in one race in the championship.

- 10.2 Championship plaquettes and titles for the Swedish Championship may be awarded if six or more boats, registered for this championship, have crossed the finish line in one race in the championship.
- 10.3 Prizes to best Mixed team and best Youth team may be awarded if applicable.
